Notes:

1. The "Responsible entity" is responsible for providing an accurate Container Weight Declaration (CWD).
2. This is usually the person in Australia who engages the road carrier or offers the container for transport by road in Australia.
3. Separating the weight of the container and its contents ensures there is no confusion as to whether the declared weight is a net weight or a gross weight. This enables the person who is relying on the CWD to determine its likely accuracy.
4. The contents of the CWD must be readily available to an authorised officer or police officer who seeks to ascertain its contents, there and then in the presence of the container (whether by examining documents located on or in the vehicle or by obtaining the information by radio or mobile or other means).
5. Information contained in the Container Weight Declaration is provided to Freight Mart International Pty Ltd by the responsible entity. Freight Mart International accepts no liability for any losses arising from any inaccuracy of information provided to Freight Mart International by the responsible entity.

**The Container Weight Declaration (CWD) is a statutory requirement for all container movements and should be sent no later than the day prior to the scheduled movement.**
